

Eucharistic Ministers and Readers

Lay Ministry covers several different areas. At Emmanuel, we have Eucharistic Ministers, Eucharistic Visitors, and Lectors (Lay Readers).

Emmanuel is blessed to have twenty-five lay people who serve as Eucharistic Ministers. These servers assist the priests by administering the chalice during the services of the Holy Eucharist on Sunday celebrated at 8:30 and 10:30. A number also serve as Eucharistic Visitors. Their role is to take the Eucharist to parishioners who are not able to come to church but who want regularly to have the Body and Blood of Christ. Six Eucharistic Ministers serve on Wednesday evenings at the Healing Service.

We have twenty three adult Lay Readers. These are people who read the first and second lessons as well as the Prayers of the People.
