

Frequently asked questions about registration

Is there an advantage to coming the morning of registration instead of mailing in the application? There is no advantage, but some people are unsure if they would want a certain class or would like only one choice, so they would like to make a decision that morning. It is also fun to meet someone who would be in your class next year.

How likely am I to get my first choice of class? Every year and every class is different. Over the last 10 years, almost everyone (98%) of the families that come to registration got a place in school; about 90% got their first choice of class. You may be on the waiting list the day of registration, but almost always the top few children on the waiting list get a place in the class.

Can my children come to the Open House/Registration morning? Yes, the information session at the Open House is short and then we take a school tour. Registration morning lasts no more than one hour and we provide some toys to keep your child busy.

Is the registration fee refundable? The fee is non-refundable, so it is up to your family to decide if it is worth \$150 to be sure about having a place in school. The first month of tuition which is due May 1st, is refundable until 30 days before the 1st day of school.

Can I change my mind about the class I choose at registration? Yes, contact the office and I can see if we have an opening in another class. We often have changes between registration in February and the start of school in August.

I came for a tour, but was not ready to make a commitment for next year; will there be openings in the spring or summer? Every year is different, every class is different...some fill up on the morning of registration; others may have an opening until the first day of school. The only way to be sure about having a place in a class is to register as early as possible; but do not hesitate to contact the school at any time to check availability.
